## Final Selection Tips

Please remember, before you confirm a leader, junior leader or delegate/family, the Home Visit is required. In addition, police background checks must be done for any adults who will be participating either as part of host families or in leadership positions.

## Friends Registration

Each delegate, leader and junior leader needs to register on the CISV Friends web site (<http://friends.cisv.org>) and claim participation in their Interchange. LICs may also register. Either the LIC or the leader will be "Activity Manager." For help or further instructions, contact your friendly IIC ReCo.

## Interchange Information Forms

Each delegate and family, leader and junior leader fills out an IIF with great care. The IIF is exchanged by partner

LICs for the pairing of delegates, so the more details that are included, the better the matches! Leaders and junior leaders get their partners by default, but the IIF is still a good way for them to introduce themselves. Both partner chapters should send the IIFs to each other by March 15.

## Training

Besides communication, one of the biggest keys to success in CISV is good training for LICs, leaders, junior leaders, delegates and their families. Please refer to IC-8.2 in the new 2008 Interchange Guide for information about training. And, the Family Guide has been updated to help with Family Training—it is also in the new Guide, IC-10.3.
